

**Chapel Street Elementary School
Dress Code Policy**

Tops:

Appropriately sized long or short sleeved shirts that have a collar, including Polo shirts, Oxford shirts, dress shirts, or blouses in solid navy blue, classic red, white, or light pink are to be worn. The shirts should be plain with no stripes, pictures, or slogans. The only exception will be tops with an approved Chapel Street School logo.

In cooler weather, appropriately sized turtlenecks, mock turtlenecks, sweaters, sweatshirts, and vests in solid navy blue, classic red, white, and light pink can be worn.

Appropriately sized t-shirts in solid navy blue, classic red, and light pink or t-shirts with an approved Chapel Street School Cheetah wear logo can be worn on days that students have a physical education class.

Bottoms:

Appropriately sized solid navy blue or tan pants, chinos, dress pants, corduroy pants, cargo pants, skirts, polo dresses, and jumpers are to be worn.

In warmer weather, appropriately sized chino shorts, skorts, and capris in solid navy or tan can be worn.

Appropriately sized solid navy blue or tan sweatpants and nylon running pants, with or without stripes on the sides, can be worn on days that students have a physical education class.

In warmer weather, appropriately sized gym shorts in solid navy blue or tan, with or without stripes on the sides, can be worn on days that students have a physical education class.

Blue jeans and colored denim pants are not allowed.

Footwear:

Closed-toe shoes or sneakers are to be worn with socks. Sneakers and socks must be worn on the days that students have a physical education class.

On inclement and cold weather days, appropriately sized boots can be worn.

For safety reasons, flip flops, backless shoes, high heels, chunky heels, and open-toe shoes and sandals are not allowed.

Jewelry:

Oversized earrings, oversized necklaces, numerous rings and bracelets are not allowed.

Headwear:

Hats, hoods, bandanas, and scarves are not allowed inside the school building.
